Hi all club members,

Hope all are well and enjoying the feel of Spring around the corner.

The WANSARC committee convened a meeting in July to review current requirements and forthcoming activities.

Additional Secretarial investigations are included regarding QSL cards.

1) MAGAZINE EDITOR.

There is still a requirement for the club to fill the position of Magazine Editor. No committee member has put forward an expression to perform this role on a permanent basis. The committee request an expression of interest from club members. There are Editable Word/PDF WANSARC Club Templates available with both the Club Header and Footer already present. The editor requires to fill in with appropriate, but not necessarily, Amateur radio related material or technical. Content can include, Calendar of Upcoming Events, Contests, and Field Days? As discussed even your local holiday to the beach and what radio related activity you did is welcomed? Any projects members have been working on? The editor could co-operate with a fellow member for assistance. News to the club membership will only continue on a notice to notice basis unless a permanent position is found.

2) QSL CARDS – CLUB MEMBERS UTILISING WANSARC AS A DISTRIBUTION POINT.

The Secretary has over the last month communicated with Amateur Radio Victoria (ARV) in regards to the process of Club members utilising WANSARC as a distribution point for their QSL cards. The process for club members utilising WANSARC is as follows.

- a) You need to be a financial member of WANSARC. Non WANSARC club members can use WANSARC as a distribution point but only upon review of an application to the Committee.
- b) You need to be a financial member of either Amateur Radio Victoria (ARV) or the Wireless Institute of Australia (WIA). Membership of both is ok.

- c) You need to be registered with the ARV QSL Bureau. If you are not registered you can apply by completing the 'Inwards QSL Bureau – Application' form which I have attached to this email. Please print and post to ARV as indicated on the form. The Distribution Point is 'WANSARC'.
- d) Please note that the following WANSARC members currently are registered with the ARV QSL Bureau, as they are either/both ARV or WIA members. In discussion with ARV the bureau has checked the register and has removed WANSARC members not registered. On the last distribution list of QSL cards dated 23-6-15 sent to WANSARC the following members are registered: VK3: CN, DWF, FAB, MRT, FEZZ, FY, KK, MEC, PI, SM, TZT, UA, ZLD.
- e) The following club members that were removed from the last ARV distribution list (register) dated 23-6-15. They were on the previous distribution list dated 31-3-15. VK3: AOF, NQ, TXZ, DIT, EFD, FTTG, NJS, NR, PEU. These members will need to contact ARV directly in regards to the collection of their cards that may be stored at ARV that were not sent to WANSARC in June 2015.
- f) Please note that there are numerous cards stored at the Clubrooms awaiting collection by WANSARC members!
